

THE BEST OF ZAMBIA

9 Days / 8 Nights

This safari is an exciting way to relive the past as you follow in the footsteps of the great explorers. The relatively remote Luangwa Valley is favoured by wildlife enthusiasts, photographers and first-timers alike and this offers you, the adventurer, the thrill of a walking safari, combined with the remote luxury of three small exclusive bush camps.

Day 1: Lusaka – South Luangwa

Make your way to Lusaka airport for your scheduled charter flight to Mfuwe and the luxurious Mfuwe Lodge, one of only two permanent lodges in the area. Enjoy an evening game drive in the South Luangwa National Park. (D)

Day 2 & 3: South Luangwa National Park

Travel by road to Chamilandu, and spend the next two days exploring the ebony groves and ox bow lagoons that attract an abundance of wildlife. Chamilandu Bush Camp offers you comfort and beauty in one of Luangwa's prime river venues. Two nights at CHAMILANDU BUSH CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 4 & 5: South Luangwa National Park

Set off along a walking trail to Chindeni, arriving in time for brunch. Surrounded by majestic hills, you will be able to view game from your accommodation on private raised wooden decking, as well as explore the evergreen forests on foot. Two nights at CHINDENI CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 6 & 7: South Luangwa National Park

Today you will walk south, towards the confluence of the Kapamba and Luangwa rivers. Bilimungwe camp holds the distinction of being the southern most camp in the National park. You will also find that Bilimungwe's permanent water

hole is a popular venue for wildlife and the shallow clear Kapamba River offers the perfect setting to cool down and relax. 2 nights at BILIMUNGWE BUSH CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 8: South Luangwa National Park

Return by road to Mfuwe Lodge for a night relaxing in luxury at this lodge offering spectacular game viewing. Overnight MFUWE LODGE (B, L, D)

Day 9: Depart

Transfer by road to Mfuwe International Airport for your scheduled charter flight back to Lusaka where your safari will conclude.

LOWER ZAMBEZI SAFARI

9 Days / 8 Nights

The Lower Zambezi is still one of the lesser known National Parks in Southern Africa but offers exceptional game viewing especially large herds of elephant and buffalo as well as good leopard and lion sightings. There is a great opportunity here for fisherman to chase one the worlds premier game fish - the Tiger Fish.

Day 1: Lower Zambezi

Today you will fly to Lower Zambezi National Park. On arrival you will be transferred to your lodge where you will enjoy stunning views of the Lower Zambezi River. Enjoy many activities: game drives, river cruises, canoe and fishing, as well as guided walks in the Zambezi Escarpment. Four nights at ROYAL ZAMBEZI LODGE (B, L, D)

Day 2-4: Lower Zambezi

Each day cross the Chongwe River into the Lower Zambezi National Park. The pristine bush, large sandy plains, floodplains and bordering riverine forests teem with herds of buffalo, elephant, lion, leopard and hippo.

Day 5: Lower Zambezi

Today you will travel by road to Chongwe River Camp, a 'bush camp' located in a wilderness area where elephant are more numerous than people. Chalets are large

Mulati tents under thatch, with luxury open air bathrooms, and fabulous views over the confluence of the Chongwe and Zambezi Rivers. FOUR NIGHTS CHONGWE RIVER CAMP (B, L, D).

Day 6-8 : Lower Zambezi

Three days to explore a different area of Lower Zambezi. Try fishing the Zambezi River, home to one of the world's premiere game fish, the Tiger Fish. Exceptional game viewing from the Lodge, either by open safari vehicle (day and night drives available), on foot, or canoe and motorboat. Chongwe specialises in walking safaris, affording time to learn secrets of the bush.

Day 9: Depart

Today you will be transferred to Royal Livingstone Airstrip for your flight back to Lusaka and the end of your safari.
