

SOUTH AFRICAN ADVENTURE

18 Days / 17 Nights

South Africa is a haven of spectacular scenery, abundant wildlife, diverse cultures and first world norms, topped with a healthy and invigorating climate, an adventure destination not to be missed. Overnight stops are at properties offering truly unique accommodation and surroundings. The tour requires a certain amount of flexibility and an adventurous spirit.

Day 1: Bushveld Camp

Today you will depart for Mpumalanga, visiting Dullstroom, Pilgrim's Rest, Bourke's Luck Potholes and the Blyde River Canyon. Overnight in DRIFTERS BUSH CAMP, with swimming pool, and stunning views. (D)

Day 2: Bushveld Camp

Early morning game walk, approximately 3 hours, before relaxing around the pool. Afternoon / night game drive to see nocturnal animals. Enjoy a hearty bush "braai" for dinner. (D)

Day 3: Hazyview

Today you will travel to Hazyview and DRIFTERS HAZYVIEW INN, a log cabin in indigenous subtropical forest on the banks of the Sabie River. Afternoon at leisure. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Kruger National Park

Today visit Kruger National Park, then you will spend the entire day game viewing. Enjoy a picnic lunch and then a night in one of the park's rest camps. (B, L, D)

Day 5-6: Swaziland/Zululand

Today you will travel to Zululand, where

you will spend two nights in DRIFTERS ZULULAND CAMP. Game walk on the reserve and an open vehicle game drive in Hluhluwe National Park. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Dolphin Coast

Today will be a day at leisure for you to enjoy the beach staying at DRIFTERS DOLPHIN COAST INN. (B, L, D)

Day 8 - 9: Drakensberg

After visiting Durban you will travel inland to the Drakensberg Mountains. and on to DRIFTERS DRAKENSBURG INN for you 2 night stay. (B, D)

Day 10: Ladybrand

Cross the Oliviershoek Pass to Sterkfontein Dam, and on to the Golden Gate National Park. White water rafting option available here. Spend the night on a farm near the town of Ladybrand (B, D)

Day 11-12: Karoo

Explore the dry Karoo interior, and enjoy an extensive walk in the mountains.. 2 nights at DRIFTERS KAROO INN. (B, L, D)

Day 13 - 15: Garden Route

Depart for Graaff-Reinet, cross the Outeniqua Mountains, spend three nights Drifters Knysna Inn. Take a boat trip around the Knysna Lagoon and through the Heads in search of dolphins and whales. One lunch and one dinner will be own expense. (B D)

Day 16-18: Cape Town

Leave Knysna and follow the "Whale Route" and on to Cape Town, check into the Drifters Cape Town Inn. Spend two days visiting Cape Point, Hout Bay, and many more highlights. hike up Table Mountain. (B)

CAPE TOWN/VIC FALLS TO JOHANNESBURG

21 Days / 20 Nights

From sensational Cape Town, to the scorched deserts of Namibia and the wildlife sanctuaries of Botswana, this tour is for true adventure seekers. Climb giant sand dunes, game drive Africa's best-known parks, and view the mighty Victoria Falls.

Day 1: Cape Town

Full day of touring including Table Mountain (weather dependent). BREAKWATER LODGE or similar. (B)

Day 2: Namaqualand

Today you will travel north to your campsite in the Namaqualand region. Camping (B, L, D)

DAY 3: Fish River Canyon

This morning you will travel to Fish River Canyon in Namibia where you will set up camp. Camping (B, L, D)

Day 4 & 5: Sesriem/ Sossusvlei

Today you will be camping on the edge of the Namib Desert. Early departure next morning for Sossusvlei for walks through the Sesriem Canyon. (B, L, D)

Day 6 & 7: Swakopmund

Today you will travel to Swakopmund. (Dinner day 6, all meals day 7 at own expense. 2 nights in bungalows or guesthouse. (Day 6 - B, L)

Day 8: Spitzkoppe

Enjoy the lunar landscapes of Moon Valley before you head north to camp in the Spitzkoppe Mountains. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Damaraland - Twyfelfontein

Travelling through Damaraland you will visit the bushmen paintings/rock engravings at Twyfelfontein. (B, L, D)

Day 10: Etosha National Park

This morning you will visit the Himba tribe, a semi-nomadic tribe before proceeding to Etosha National Park for a game drive. (B, L, D)

Day 11 & 12: Etosha National Park

Early morning and late afternoon game drives at Okaukuejo and Namutoni campsites. (B, L, D)

Day 13 & 14: Okavango River

Today you will enter the Caprivi Strip where you will camp on the Okavango River. Next day relax on a sunset mokoro excursion on the Okavango. (B, L, D)

Day 15: Kwando River - Caprivi

Today you will travel to camp on the banks of the Kwando River. Game excursions in this area. (B, L, D)

Day 16 & 17: Livingstone/ Victoria Falls

Today we travel to Victoria Falls. Days at leisure. (All meals excluding 1 lunch & 1 dinner).

Day 18: Chobe River

Today you will cross into Botswana and camp on the banks of the Chobe River. (B, L, D)

Day 19: Nata (Makgadikgadi Pans)

Visit the Makgadikgadi Pans (weather permitting) for a truly unforgettable sunset. (B, L, D)

Day 20: Limpopo Area

Your last night will be camping near the mighty Limpopo River. (B, L, D)

Day 21: Johannesburg

Return to Johannesburg (B, L)
