

This tour offers a choice of 3 or 5 star accommodation depending on your budget, whilst still visiting all the highlights of Oman. The tour is designed to highlight the spectacular desert and mountain scenery as well as an opportunity to see some of the historic and other interesting sights. From its modern and cosmopolitan capital Muscat to the seafaring village and trading port of Sur the tour continues on to Nizwa with its wealth of cultural and ancient landmarks and Salalah with its glorious traditions and wonders of nature.

Day 1: Muscat

Upon your arrival in Muscat, you will be met and transferred to your hotel.

Day 2: Muscat

Full day city tour. Highlights include the Oman Museum, Natural History Museum, and the PDO Exhibition Center. A visit to a traditional Muttrah Souq Al Alam Palace, the historic Mirani and Jalali built in the 16th century, Qantab fishing village & Corniche Fish Market. Overnight at hotel.

Day 3: Sur

Depart for Sur, stopping regularly for sightseeing en route. Visit Wadi Dayqah - a beautiful valley with rugged trekking trails and cool turquoise pools, Daghmar, Dibab with its stunning cave formations, and Finns beach. In Sur, visit a Dhov building yard (traditional Arabian ship) before checking into your hotel for the night.

Day 4: Nizwa

Spend a full day exploring Wadi Bani Khalid- an Oasis in the middle of the

barren and dry mountains, and the great Arabian Desert of Wahiba, with sight seeing en route. In Wahiba, you will have a chance to visit a Bedouin house and experience a camel ride and sand dune drive before proceeding to Nizwa, the cultural capital of Oman for overnight.

Day 5: Nizwa

Spend the day on a tour of Nizwa, Bahla and Jabrin. Visit Nizwa and Jabrin Forts, a pottery shop and souk. Overnight at your hotel in Nizwa.

Day 6: Salalah

Transfer to Seeb Airport for a flight to Salalah. In the afternoon, enjoy a half day city tour of West Salalah, including visit to Job's tomb and Mughsail Beach, before returning to your hotel for the night.

Day 7: Salalah

After breakfast at the hotel, your city tour of East Salalah starts with a visit to Village Taqa, before continuing on to the ruins of Samhurum and Mirbat. Overnight at your hotel in Salalah.

Day 8: Muscat

Enjoy a relaxed breakfast at your hotel. In the afternoon, you will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Muscat. On arrival in Muscat, transfer from the airport's arrival terminal to the departure terminal, and board the flight for your onward journey.
