

# EAST AFRICA OVERLAND ADVENTURE

12 Days / 11 Nights

Combining the highlights of both Kenya and Tanzania, this participation camping safari offers exceptional value for money, especially suited for those with an adventurous spirit and a lower budget. You will visit the renowned game parks – the Masai Mara, Ngorongoro Crater, the Serengeti, as well as other lesser known areas. You will also have the opportunity to interact with some of the local tribes.

## Day 1: Nairobi

Upon arrival in Nairobi, make your own way to your hotel.

## Day 2: Lake Nakuru

Enjoy fantastic views of the Great Rift Valley as you travel to Lake Nakuru National Park. Game drive before settling in at Kembu. (B, L, D)

## Day 3: Lake Naivasha

After a short drive from camp on the shores of Lake Naivasha, you will have time to relax, watch the Hippo's, take in the scenery and visit Elsamere for afternoon tea. (B, L, D)

## Day 4 & 5: Masai Mara

Today you will drive to your camp, located adjacent Masai Mara Game Reserve, passing Masai villages. Here you have two nights to enjoy this game reserve famous for its large herds of plains game and predators. (B, L, D)

## Day 6: Lake Victoria

Leave the Masai Mara and travel to Tanzania heading to the shores of Lake

Victoria - the largest Lake in Africa. Afternoon at leisure, before camping on the waters edge. (B, L, D)

## Day 7: Serengeti

Enter the Serengeti National Park, boasting huge concentrations of plains game, predators and birdlife. Spend the night at Seronera campsite. (B, L, D)

## Day 8: Ngorongoro Crater

After a morning game drive head to Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Overnight at Simba Camp on the edge of Ngorongoro Crater. (B, L, D)

## Day 9: Masai Mara

Today you will spend most of the day game viewing in the Crater. After lunch, on the Crater floor, you will head back to you camp for two nights amongst the Masai people (B,L,D)

## Day 10: Engaruka Village

Explore Engaruka Village and surrounds on foot, Spend time in the cultural boma, visit Engaruka Ruins, see Masai dances and barter in the markets. (B, L, D)

## Day 11: Arusha

Today you will travel to Arusha, at the foot of Mount Meru. Explore the lively town and local markets. (B)

## Day 12: Transfer To Nairobi

After breakfast take the shuttle bus back to Nairobi or Jomo Kenyatta International Airport where your safari ends (B)

# JOHANNESBURG TO NAIROBI

30 Days / 29 Nights

The ultimate experience for the young and very adventurous is an overland camping expedition through Africa. This trip is certainly not for the faint-hearted as adventure lies around every corner. A great deal of participation and flexibility from all passengers on this trip ensures the success of the tour.

## Day 1 & 2: Johannesburg – Zimbabwe

Depart Johannesburg and head north to a bush camp in the Limpopo Valley. On day 2 enjoy a morning walk before travelling to the Great Zimbabwe Ruins. Spend the afternoon exploring the ruins. (Camp/Cabin B, L)

## Day 3 & 4: Bulawayo – Matobo – Hwange

Drive through Bulawayo to camp in Matobo. Finish the day with an open vehicle game drive into Matobo National Park. Day 4 take an afternoon game drive in Hwange National Park. (Camp B,L,D)

## Day 5 - 7: Victoria Falls – Kafue Camp

Travel to Victoria Falls for two days. Try bungee jumping or white-water rafting (own expense). Drifters Inn (B, L). Day 7 cross the bridge over the Zambezi Gorge into Zambia and on to camp on the Kafue River. (Inn/Camp B, L, D)

## Day 8 - 10: Zambezi

Embark on a canoe adventure, camping at night and game viewing during the day. Finish at Chongwe River. Transfer to Kafue camp by boat. (Camp B, L, D)

## Day 11 - 13: Luangwa National Park

Continue north along the Great East

Road, set up camp for the night. On day 12 drive to camp on the banks of the Luangwa River for two nights with game viewing in the southern region of the park. (Camp B, L, D)

## Day 14 - 16: Lake Malawi

Cross Malawi into Lilongwe and on to camp for two nights on the beach of Lake Malawi. On day 16 follow the road along the lakeshore north to spend another night. (Camp B, L, D)

## Day 17 & 18: Mikumi – Dar Es Salaam

Cross into Tanzania, and camp in the remote village of Mikumi. (Camping B, L, D). On day 18 Spend the day exploring Dar Es Salaam, and camp the night on the North Coast. (Camp B, L, D)

## Day 19 - 22: Zanzibar

A short ferry ride you will take you to the island of Zanzibar, spending the next four days at leisure. (Cabin B, L, D)

## Day 23: Zanzibar – Dar Es Salaam

Catch a ferry back to the mainland, and camp north of the capital. (Camp B, L, D)

## Day 24 & 25: Arusha

Camp for 2 nights in the bustling town of Arusha. (Camp B, L, D)

## Day 26 - 28: Serengeti – Ngorongoro

First day game viewing en route from Arusha to Serengeti. Overnight at Seronera Camp. Full day game viewing next day before heading to Simba Camp on the lip of the Ngorongoro crater. Next day game viewing on the crater floor before returning to Arusha for the night. (Camp B, L, D)

## Day 29 & 30: Nairobi

Cross the border to Kenya and onto Nairobi. Spend the night at a simple hotel with an evening farewell meal (own expense). After breakfast the safari ends (Inn, B,L)
