

KENYA FAMILY SAFARI

9 Days / 8 Nights

This safari has been designed with the whole family in mind. The selected accommodation is child-friendly, well located and offers a choice of activities which are educational and fun for the young and young at heart. It visits the best game viewing areas of Kenya where children can view the animals from the safety of vehicles. The safari is set at family-friendly pace with child-friendly guides.

Day 1: Nairobi

On arrival in Nairobi you will be met and transferred to your hotel. 1 night THE STANLEY HOTEL (B)

Day 2: Nairobi – Aberdare National Park

Drive to Aberdare National Park for lunch. From here you will be transferred to your lodge, a unique property overlooking a floodlit waterhole and salt lick that attracts a host of wildlife. Overnight THE ARK LODGE (B, L, D)

Day 3 & 4 : Aberdare - Samburu

Rejoin your driver-guide and travel by road to the vast semi-desert lands of Northern Kenya and Samburu Game Reserve. After lunch embark on a game drive. Day 4 morning and afternoon game drive exploring the forests near the Uaso Nyiro River, which flows through the dry landscape. Two nights at SAMBURU INTREPIDS CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 5: Samburu – Sweetwaters

Travel by road to Sweetwaters Game Sanctuary, situated in the sprawling

OI Pejeta Ranch. An orphaned rhino reared by hand provides a wonderful treat for children, as does the chimpanzee sanctuary - home to rescued chimps from the Jane Goodall Institute in Burundi. In the afternoon, you will be taken on a game drive. One night at SWEETWATERS CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 6: Sweetwaters – Lake Nakuru

Drive past the northern tip of the Aberdares Mountains and descend into the Great Rift Valley and Lake Nakuru. This lake is famous as a bird sanctuary and noted for its huge concentration of flamingoes. Embark on a late afternoon game drive. Overnight accommodation SAROVA LION HIL LODGE (B, L, D)

Day 7 & 8: Lake Nakuru – Masai Mara

Drive to Naivasha airstrip for a scheduled flight to Masai Mara. This area is famous for enormous herds of wildebeest and zebra, which migrate every July to September. The afternoon will be spent on a game drive exploring the rolling hills

and plains for sightings of these animals. Spend Day 8 with morning and afternoon game viewing. Two nights at MARA INTREPIDS CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 9: Masai Mara – Nairobi

After breakfast at camp you will be transferred to the airstrip for your flight back to Nairobi, where your tour ends.

KENYA ADVENTURE CAMPING

8 Days / 7 Nights

This safari is for those that want to see the highlights of Kenya at an affordable price. This budget camping safari visits the top 3 game areas in Kenya – Masai Mara Game Reserve, Samburu Game Reserve and Lake Nakuru National Park.

Day 1: Nairobi to Nanyuki

Leaving Nairobi you will head north to Nanyuki, made popular due to its proximity to Mount Kenya, Kenya's highest peak at 5199 m. (L, D)

Day 2: Nanyuki to Samburu

Today you will drive through the Mt Kenya area to Samburu National Reserve. It is a remote reserve and attracts a wide range of animals. This afternoon you will take a game drive in the reserve, which is home to most of the Big 5 (except the rhino), as well as some unusual animals only found in Northern Kenya - grevy's zebra, beisa oryx, reticulated giraffe, somali ostrich, and geranuk. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Samburu to Nakuru

Today you will depart Samburu and head to Lake Nakuru. Overnight just outside Lake Nakuru National Park. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Lake Nakuru National Park

Today you will visit Lake Nakuru National Park, famous for the thousands of flamingos that flock to this soda lake's edge. The day will be spent searching for black and white rhino, the elusive leopard, buffalo, giraffe, various antelope and the occasional hippo. (B / L / D)

Day 5: Nakuru to Masai Mara (B / L / D)

Today you will depart from Nakuru and pass through the town of Narok, arriving at your campsite in the Masai Mara.

Day 6: Masai Mara Game Reserve (B / L / D)

You will spend the day on a game drive viewing the abundance of wildlife in this "Garden of Eden."

Day 7: Masai Mara to Nairobi (B)

After breakfast, you will head back to Nairobi arriving late afternoon and the end of your safari.
