

NAMIBIA SELF-DRIVE

9 Days / 8 Nights

This self-drive package is the perfect option for those that want some flexibility and freedom but still with accommodation pre-booked on each night of the trip. It offers exceptional value for money especially for families.

Day 1: Windhoek

On arrival at Windhoek, collect your vehicle and information pack and drive to your overnight stay at PENSION MONI.

Day 2 & 3: Sossusvlei Surrounds

Today you will drive south to NAMIB DESERT LODGE, situated in the surrounds of the majestic Sossusvlei. Sossusvlei is home to the surreal "Dead Vlei", gigantic star-shaped mountains of sand, ranging in warm tints that contrast with large white pans at their base. 1 night at NAMIB DESERT LODGE

Day 4: Swakopmund

Today you will drive to the coastal town of Swakopmund, staying at INDONGO GUESTHOUSE - an ideal base for exploring Swakopmund, the Cape Cross Seal Reserve and the surrounding Namib Desert. (B)

Day 5: Damaraland

This morning you will drive north along the coast past the Cape Cross reserve to Khorixas in Damaraland. 1 night at IGOWATI LODGE. (B)

Day 6 & 7: Etosha Surrounds

Today you will head to Etosha National Park, seeing the Twyfelfontein Rock engravings, and Petrified forest along the way. Overnight will be at ETOSHA SAFARI CAMP on the fringe of the park. Each tented bungalow is decorated with artistically painted floors, and furniture created by local Namibian craftsmen. Etosha National Park features the Etosha Pan, a vast expanse of white cracked mud, shimmering with mirages. The park is full of wildlife, some of which are rare and endangered. ETOSHA SAFARI CAMP. (B)

Day 8: Central Namibia

Head south toward Windhoek and OKAPUKA RANCH, situated 30km from Windhoek where you will overnight. Enjoy facilities and activities available at the hotel. (B)

Day 9: Departure

Today you will drive the 30km to Windhoek Airport for your onward flight. This will be the end of your tour. (B)

NAMIBIA ADVENTURE CAMPING

12 Days / 11 Nights

This overland camping safari covers all of the highlights of central and northern Namibia, but concentrates on "off the beaten track" routes and attractions. This is a participation camping safari designed for those who want to "rough it" and see Namibia at its most wild. Flexibility, a willingness to participate and an awareness of the elements are essential in order to get the most out of this tour.

Day 1 & 2: Namib Desert

You will depart early afternoon for Namibrand Nature Reserve. You will enjoy a traditional meal under the desert sky at sunset and awake to desert vistas that extend further than the eye can see. Enjoy extensive guided walks and game drives day & night. 2 nights DRIFTERS DESERT CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 3: Sossusvlei

After helping pack up camp, you will continue through the desert to Sesriem Canyon and the awesome Sossusvlei dunes. Explore the dunes by 4WD, before moving on to camp wild in the desert. 1 night CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 4 & 5: Swakopmund

Today you will cross the Namib Naukluft Park, to Swakopmund. Explore this coastal holiday town. Enjoy an evening meal at a local nightspot (own expense). 2 nights at SWAKOPMUND INN. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Skeleton Coast - Spitskop

Today you will travel up Skeleton Coast to the Cape Cross Seal Colony, before venturing inland to camp in the wild. Overnight CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Twyfelfontein – Palmwag

Today is a long day visiting the bushman rock engravings, travelling through Damaraland and crossing the Grootberg before you set up camp at the oasis of Palmwag. CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Day 8 & 9: Cunene River - Epupa Falls

Travelling through the heart of the Kaokovelt you will head north to Epupa Falls and camp for 2 nights. Explore the area surrounding the falls, and during your time here you should get to interact with the nomadic Himba people, a tribe who live in this inhospitable region. 1 night CAMPING (B,L,D).

Day 10 & 11: Etosha

Today you will enter Etosha National Park and search for big game for which the park is well known. Spend an evening at a floodlit waterhole, watching the animals come down to drink. Enjoy extensive game drives within the park and dine one evening at a camp restaurant (own expense). 2 nights CAMPING (B, L, D)

Day 12: Depart

Today you will leave the park and travel back to Windhoek arriving late afternoon for the conclusion of your tour. (B, L)
