

MT KILIMANJARO CLIMB

7 Days / 6 Nights

To climb Mount Kilimanjaro is an ultimate experience. This opportunity lies within the range of anyone who is reasonably fit; no technical mountaineering skills are required. Dominating its surrounding landscape and lying on the border of Tanzania and Kenya, the physical beauty of this mountain is overwhelming. The following itinerary is based on the Marangu Route.

Day 1: Moshi

Arrive Moshi for overnight.

Day 2: Mandara

After breakfast and briefing you will drive to the Park gate, register and commence the climb, walking through the rain forest to the Mandara encampment, located at (9000ft) (2700m) dinner and overnight.

Day 3: Horombo

You will leave the rain forest and follow an ascending path on the open moorlands to the Horombo encampment, located at (12000ft) (3700m) dinner and overnight.

Day 4: Kibo

Ascending you will pass the last watering point, walking onto the saddle of Kilimanjaro between the peaks of

Kibo and Mawenzi. Arriving at the Kibo encampment located at (15000ft) (4700m) dinner and rest.

Day 5: Uhuru Peak

Shortly after midnight you will commence the climb to the summit of Gilman's point located on the crater rim at 5861m, then ascend to Uhuru Peak which is the highest point in Africa (5895m). From here you will descend, continuing straight to the Horombo encampment for dinner and overnight.

Day 6: Moshi

The descent continues past the Mandara encampment down to the park gate. Drive to Moshi for overnight.

Day 7: Depart

Depart Moshi.

TANZANIA UNDER CANVAS

7 Days / 6 Nights

Day 1: Arusha – Lake Manyara

Today you will travel by road to Lake Manyara National Park. Arrive at camp in time for dinner. (L, D)

Day 2: Lake Manyara National Park

Morning and afternoon game drives exploring the wilderness of Lake Manyara National Park. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Lake Manyara – Serengeti

Travel to the world-renowned Serengeti National Park, arriving at your campsite in time for an afternoon game drive. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Serengeti

Full day of discovery in the Serengeti. Excellent opportunities to get close to a range of wildlife on your morning and afternoon game drives. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Serengeti – Ol Duvai – Ngorongoro

Morning drive to Ol Duvai Gorge, where you will enjoy a picnic lunch. Continue on to Ngorongoro Crater, and embark on a walk on Oldeani before dinner at your Ngorongoro camp. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Karatu - Lake Manyara - Arusha

Today you will travel down onto the Crater floor to see the abundant wildlife in this unique setting. Picnic lunches will be provided and you will return to camp in the late afternoon (B L D)

Day 7: Arusha

After breakfast you will drive back to Arusha for your farewell lunch and the end of your safari.
