

HIGHLIGHTS OF BOTSWANA

14 Days / 13 Nights

This safari is for those that want a more extensive visit of Botswana's wildlife areas at a very reasonable price. This mobile camping safari offers wild camping with a level of comfort that ensures an enjoyable time. The 3m x 3m bow tents each contain a camp cot, mattress, pillows and duvet. Shower and toilet tents are set up in a central area, usually one for every 6 people.

Day 1: Nata – Makgadikgadi Pans

Depart Victoria Falls, and enter Botswana via the Kazungula border. Picnic lunch en-route, and arrive in Nata late afternoon. After the staff have set up camp, you will head out to explore the pans and enjoy your first Botswana sunset. CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 2 & 3: Nxai Pan

Head west across the northern part of Makgadikgadi to Nxai Pan National Park, where you will spend two days exploring this area, once part of an ancient lake. Today the region is a huge grassy pan teeming with antelope. CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 4: Maun, Tree Lodge

A short drive will take you to the frontier town of Maun, where you will have the opportunity to relax at your lodge and spend the afternoon at leisure by the bar or swimming pool. (B)

Day 5 & 6: Okavango – Moremi

Visit Moremi Game Reserve. This massive reserve boasts an amazing abundance

and variety of wildlife. Two nights at XAKANAXA CAMP. (B, L, D)

Day 7 & 8: Khwai – Moremi

Morning game drive along the Khwai river flood plains to Khwai. Spend the next two days in this area embarking on morning and evening game drives to take in the exceptional wildlife. CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 9 & 10: Savute – Chobe

Today you will travel by road to Savute, South Western Chobe, a contrast of rocky hills and open, dry marshland offering beautiful scenery and unique wildlife. Here you will be taken to view the San bushman paintings hidden in the rocky outcrops. CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 11 & 12: Serondela – Chobe

Spend two nights at Serondela and take game drives along the Chobe River. Known for large herds of elephant and buffalo, game viewing by boat is a great opportunity to see wildlife from a different perspective. CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 13 & 14: Victoria Falls

A morning game drive along the Chobe River, then cross the border to your Victoria Falls hotel for lunch. In the afternoon visit the mighty Victoria Falls. A farewell dinner at a restaurant in town will finish the evening. Your safari will conclude after breakfast on the final morning. HOTEL (B)

TASTE OF BOTSWANA

10 Days / 9 Nights

This mobile camping safari caters for your every need and comfort, with extras that deliver an exciting wilderness camping experience. The spacious (25m²) domed tents have comfortable beds with crisp linen as well as bed-side table lamps and hand basins. The shared bathroom enclosure houses W.C.'s and hot bucket showers (2 bathrooms per 7 guests).

Day 1 & 2: Maun – Okavango Delta

From Maun you will be transferred by light aircraft into the heart of the Delta. Here you will be taken by Mokoro (dug-out canoe) through crystal clear channels and waterways to undertake game-viewing walks on the islands. Spend two nights at a special campsite in a private concession area, with a compliment of camp staff to cater for you. (B,L,D)

Day 3 & 4: Moremi Wildlife Reserve

You will continue by light aircraft to Khwai, tucked into the north-eastern sector of the Okavango. Your days are spent on extensive game viewing drives. Camping will be in Moremi Wildlife Reserve. (B,L,D)

Days 5 - 8: Chobe National Park

Travel up to Savute and spend two nights camped next to the dry Savute Channel. This area is excellent for lion and other predator viewing. From Savute you will travel to Northern Chobe and camp for two nights in the Serondela area, the heart of elephant country, giving you the opportunity to spend many hours watching the huge herds. Camp in Chobe National Park. (B,L,D)

Day 9: Victoria Falls

It is a short drive from Chobe National Park to Victoria Falls. Your stay here will allow you the thrill of viewing the magnificent Victoria Falls (entrance is included) or to relax and enjoy the varied entertainment facilities at Victoria Falls township. Overnight accommodation is at Matetsi Water Lodge, in a twin bedded room with private facilities. (B,L,D)

Day 10: Depart

Your safari ends this morning after breakfast at the hotel. (B)
