

VICTORIA FALLS & CHOBE FLY-IN

5 Days / 4 Nights

Day 1 & 2:

Fly from Johannesburg to Livingstone. Transfer to the hotel of your choice. Sun International hotels include bed and breakfast, unlimited access to the Falls and Zambezi cruise. (B) A wide choice of activities are available (See Page 17).

Day 3 & 4:

After breakfast, transfer by road to your accommodation of choice. Chobe National

Park in Botswana, some 100km west of Victoria Falls, is home to one of the largest concentration of elephants in Africa. Game activities include drives in 4 x 4 open vehicles and boat cruises on the Chobe River. (B, L, D)

Day 5:

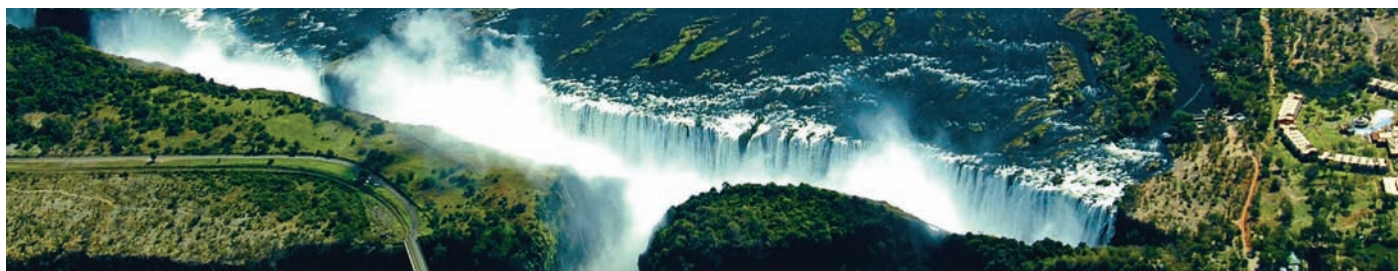
Today you will be tavel back to Livingstone for your return flight to Johannesburg.

ZIMBABWE CANOE SAFARI

4 Days / 3 Nights

They say the ultimate in adventure, excitement and seeing Africa in the wild is on a canoe safari - and the best place to canoe is on the Zambezi River in Mana Pools National Park, home to an amazing concentration of wildlife.

Day 1:

The canoe trail begins in Mana Pools National Park, where you will meet your guide. Transfer to the Ruckomecvi River mouth, launch your canoes after lunch to begin the first day's leisurely paddle arriving for 1 night at VUNDU CAMP.

Day 2:

At dawn set off on the river by canoe to view the sun rising over the Zambezi, stopping at a special site for breakfast. Spend the day game viewing, birdwatching and fishing,

while slowly canoeing down the river arriving for 1 night at CHESSA CAMP.

Day 3:

A wonderful dawn departure canoeing down the river stopping at one of the islands or inlets along the way, allowing you to walk in this scenic area, overnight at ILALA CAMP.

Day 4:

Today you may rise a little later if you prefer, or take an early morning walk before breakfast. After which your tour concludes.
