### Samburu Intrepids

Samburu Intrepids is set in the semi-arid desert of northern Kenya in the quiet western section of Samburu National Reserve. This luxury tented camp has been designed to recreate the romance and charm of an East African safari as undertaken in the early years of the 20th century. The camp consists of 27 luxurious tents overlooking the riverbank, and offers large four-poster beds, classic safari furniture, modern ensuite bathrooms and secluded verandahs. Buffet luncheons and candlelight dinners are served on an elevated deck amidst the high shade trees.

### Samburu Game Lodge

Samburu Game Lodge is set in 10 acres of pristine riverine forest on the bank of the Uaso Nyiro River, a rugged landscape with a backdrop of jagged mountains and its own indigenous wildlife unique to the northern region of Samburu Reserve. All rooms are decorated using the finest materials and fabrics, have en suite bathrooms, and all have private balconies overlooking the river. The open sided dining room faces the river, and allows guest to enjoy the sights and sounds of the river as they dine.

### Larsens Tented Camp

Larsens Tented Camp is well located on the banks of the Uaso Nyiro River. Each of the 17 luxury tents faces the river and has a private deck where you can sit and observe the wildlife. The spacious luxury tents are beautifully furnished with comfortable beds, full linen, en-suite bathrooms with flush toilet, vanity and hot showers. The camp also has a bar tent, a lounge and a swimming pool. Breakfast, lunch and dinner at Larsens are all a la carte, you might take breakfast under the shade of a fig tree, lunch on the deck overlooking the river, and dinner on the tree deck with waterhole view.

### Ashnil Samburu Camp

Ashnil Samburu Camp sits in Buffalo Springs Game Reserve and features 24 deluxe en-suite tents. Each of the exclusive deluxe tents gives a perfect view of the Ewaso Nyiro River and consists of a sitting area, luggage rack and en-suite facilities. Enjoy delicious international, oriental and African traditional cuisines or 'bubbly bush dinners' and breakfast and picnic lunch boxes for creative dining options. The camp facilities include a swimming pool for adults and children, a wonderful viewing deck with a view of the Ewaso Nyiro River, well stocked bar, gift shop, dining area and lounge area.

### Elsa's Kopje

Elsa's Kopje is almost invisible to the eye as you approach its home on Mughwango Hill. It blends into the rocky crags of the "kopje" (small hill), built above the site of George Adamson's original campsite. Every cottage is the ultimate 'room-with-a-view', uniquely designed and crafted, incorporating the natural features of the rocky hillside. Each cottage has spacious double or twin beds with en suite, elegantly appointed bathrooms. There is an open bar, lounge and dining room with an exceptionally inviting infinity pool overlooking the Meru plains.

### Olonana

Mara Intrepids sits above a sweeping bend in the Talek River, at the confluence of the Maasai Mara's 4 game-viewing areas. Mara Intrepids camp is a short drive from the Mara River, where more than a million wildebeest and zebra make their perilous migration crossing every year. The camp has 30 elegant guest tents which sit on a shady raised platforms enjoying sweeping views over the riverbanks. Each has a large 4-poster bed, traditional style furniture and modern ensuite bathrooms, along with a central dining room and swimming pool.

### Mara Serena

Mara Serena is set high on a hill above the plains of the Masai Mara. ### Mara Plains Camp

Mara Plains Camp is a small, high quality, luxury tented camp located along the Ntiakatek River within the private Olare Orok Conservancy. ### Kichwa Tembo

Laid out along the banks of the Sabaringo River on the edge of the Oloololo escarpment, Kichwa Tembo Masai Mara Tented Camp looks out onto the seemingly endless plains of the Masai Mara. Set on a private concession leased from Masai landlords in the less populated northern part of the Mara, the camp offers total seclusion coupled with abundant wildlife. Forty spacious tents, twelve of them luxury suites, are laid out in immaculate grounds, with leisurely groups of warthog feeding right outside the tent doors.

### Little Governors Camp

Little Governor's is intimate in character, with just 17 luxury en-suite tents tucked around a large watering hole that teems with both birds and wildlife. The camp is approached by a boat ride across the Mara River, then an escorted walk through the riverine forest. Vehicles are left on the far river bank so the camp is quiet and undisturbed. The guest tents at Little Governors' have recently been renovated and now have great wooden decks with large verandahs for guests to enjoy the constant game activity that takes place around the watering hole at the camp.

### Sekenani Camp

Comprising fifteen well designed tents, Sekenani offers comfortable tented accommodation with good cuisine and friendly staff. Simple elegance is the Sekenani style. The camp is built at the source of the Sekenani River which rises from a rock pool at the east end of the camp and forms the stream which flows in front of each tent. The tents themselves are large and raised off the ground on platforms. Each one is secluded and set into the bush in such a way as to ensure privacy. The camp is ideal for families, singles or groups.

### Saruni Camp

Saruni is a deluxe safari lodge located just outside the Masai Mara National Reserve. With luxury accommodation for only 12 guests in six cottages, it is set in a remote valley and offers excellent service and cuisine. The rooms are furnished with colonial antiques, Persian carpets and African art. A unique feature of Saruni is its collection of books and its library with thousands of rare books. What sets Saruni apart is its private location.

### Mara Explorer Camp

Situated on a broad, forested bend of the Talek River in the centre of the Maasai Mara National Reserve this camp features 10 luxurious tents with an open-air bathtub, and private river frontage with views, hand-carved mahogany furniture, writing desks, personal closets and luxury individual bathrooms. This luxurious tented camp lies at the confluence of the reserve's four main game-viewing areas, and enjoys prime views of the spectacular wildebeest migration between June and September.

## AMBOSELI & TSAVO

Amboseli National Park is 260km from Nairobi, on the border with the neighboring country of Tanzania. Its magnificent situation at the foot of Mount Kilimanjaro, combined with its excellent opportunities to view Kenya's animals, make it one of the most-visited safari parks in Kenya. Amboseli is renowned for its large herds of free-ranging African elephants as well as huge herds of wildebeest and many other animals including giraffes, lions, monkeys, zebras, hyenas and antelope.

Tsavo National Park, a vast wilderness comprising Tsavo-East and Tsavo-West, is one of the biggest wildlife parks in East Africa covering an area of 20,700 sq kms, the size of Wales or Israel! The park offers tremendous views with diverse habitats ranging from mountains, river forests, plains, lakes and wooded grassland, and is, of course, home to all of Africa's most famous wildlife.
