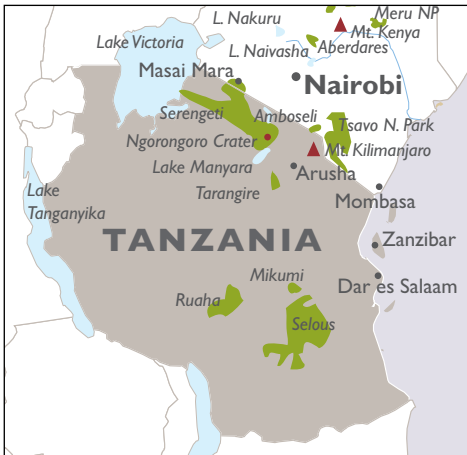


Famous for its national parks which host some of nature's greatest wildlife spectacles, Tanzania is incredibly beautiful and unspoilt. This safari visits the Serengeti, home to nearly three million wildebeest and zebra which migrate annually, as well as Ngorongoro Crater, which has a series of eco-systems within the Crater walls. The lodges are five star and should satisfy the most discerning client.



Day 1: Nairobi - Lake Manyara

This morning you will be transferred to Wilson airport for your flight to Lake Manyara. On arrival you will be transferred to your accommodation and after a leisurely lunch set out on an afternoon game drive. Overnight LAKE MANYARA TREE LODGE. (B, L, D)

Day 2: Ngorongoro Crater

Today you will travel by road to Ngorongoro Crater – a wonderful haven for wildlife. Your accommodation is perched on the crater rim. Two nights NGORONGORO CRATER LODGE. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Ngorongoro

Your day will be one of discovery with game viewing in the Crater. Ngorongoro Crater is unique in that almost all the wildlife live within the Crater walls. Rhino can be seen regularly as well as prides of lion and other predators like cheetah. Lunch will be taken on the Crater floor. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Serengeti National Park

After breakfast you will fly to Serengeti Under Canvas. Serengeti Under Canvas camp provides the ultimate viewpoint for the Great Migration herds. Accommodation is in a Bedouin style tent with double bed, ensuite bathroom, separate w.c. and al fresco bucket shower. Activities include morning and afternoon game drives in open 4x4 vehicles. Three nights at SERENGETI UNDER CANVAS CAMP. (B, L, D)

Days 5 & 6: Serengeti National Park

Early morning and evening game drives. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Depart

After breakfast, you will be transferred to your flight to Nairobi via Kilimanjaro International Airport. On arrival you will be met and transferred to your onward flight or city hotel in Nairobi. (B)

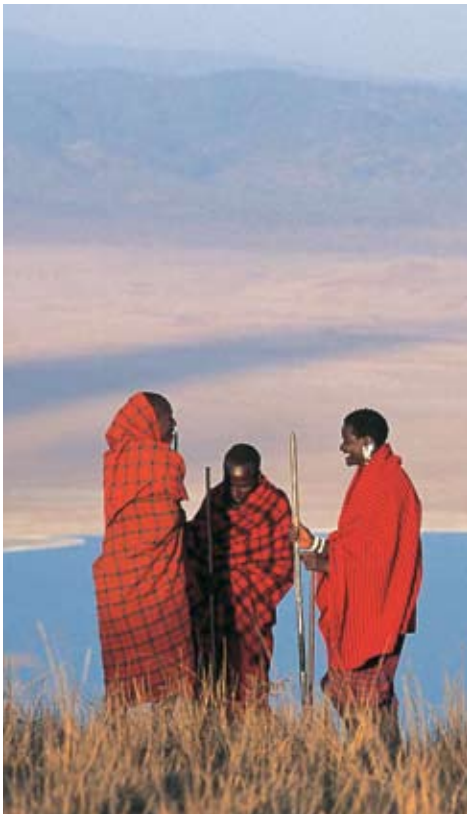
