

They say to climb Mount Kilimanjaro is the ultimate adventure rush. This opportunity lies within the range of anyone who is reasonably fit, as no technical mountaineering skills are required. Dominating its surrounding landscape and lying on the border of Tanzania and Kenya, the physical beauty of this mountain is overwhelming.

Machame Route: 8 Days / 7 Nights (6 day hike)

This route offers some of the best scenery ascending from the western side of Kilimanjaro, and descending down the south face. Each trip is lead by a senior guide, with other guides in a ratio of approximately one guide per 2 or 3 climbers. The Machame Route is an opportunity to learn mountain skills as it maximises the time on the mountain to acclimatise and well as climbing at a more leisurely pace. Nights are spent in high-quality 3-man alpine tents sleeping a maximum of two persons per tent. All your supplies and camping equipment are portered up for you and all your meals are prepared.

Rongai Route: 8 Days / 7 Nights (6 day hike)

This route begins on the Northern side of the mountain and is one of the least travelled routes. It is a very long drive to the starting point but your reward is the fantastic views. The Rongai Route approaches the highest mountain in Africa from the north and has a relatively gentle gradient and short daily stages. There are magnificent views throughout, glaciers and ice cliffs of the summit, and across the East African plains far below. Nights are spent in high-quality 3-man alpine tents' sleeping a maximum of two persons per tent. All your supplies and camping equipment are portered up for you and all your meals are prepared.

Marangu Route: 7 Days / 6 Nights (5 day hike)

The Marangu Route is the most common route, and gives the novice hiker a good opportunity to reach the summit. This is the easiest and the most popular route up Kilimanjaro with excellent well-defined trails. Marangu is the classic trail with comfortable mountain huts and good facilities spaced at ideal locations.

Umbwe Route: 8 Days / 7 Nights (6 day hike)

The Umbwe Route is incredibly beautiful and one of the shortest routes to the Southern Glaciers and the Western Breach of Kibo. It is quite taxing due to the relatively fast ascent to higher altitudes, but the rewards are plentiful. Being fit and acclimatized will increase your chance of success.

Lemosho Route: 9 Days / 8 Nights (7 day hike)

The Lemosho Route starts on the western side and is an unspoilt, remote and very beautiful route to the Shira Plateau. The trail leads up to the western edge of the Shira Plateau, and the hike across the plateau is said to be one of the most stunning in Africa. (Climbers may be accompanied on the first day by an armed ranger, as the forests around the Lemosho Glades are rich with buffalo, elephant and other big game animals).
