

UGANDA GORILLA SAFARI

6 Days / 5 Nights

They say to see the gorillas is one of the most exciting and humbling experiences in the bush. This safari offers you the opportunity to see the mountain gorillas in Uganda or Rwanda as well as the opportunity to see the chimpanzees at Ngamba Island on Lake Victoria. The safari uses top quality local hotels and lodges, and transport is by customised vehicle.

Day 1: Entebbe

On arrival at Entebbe airport you will be transferred to your hotel. The afternoon is spent at Ngamba Island Chimpanzee Sanctuary. One night at LAKE VICTORIA ENTEBBE HOTEL. (B)

Day 2: Entebbe – Bwindi Or Rwanda

After an early breakfast you will head west, to either Bwindi Impenetrable Forest Uganda, or Parc National des Volcans, Rwanda. 3 NIGHTS accommodation BUHOMA LODGE, BWINDI or MOUNTAIN GORILLA VIEW LODGE, RWANDA. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Bwindi Or Rwanda

Today you will take an early morning trek into the forest on the slopes of the volcanoes, in search of Mountain Gorillas. You will return either in time for lunch or later depending on the location of the gorillas. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Bwindi Or Rwanda

This morning if you have opted for two gorilla treks, you will again set off into the forest. If you have decided not to trek the gorillas again, you will have the opportunity to be taken on a forest walk with a local guide. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Bwindi/Rwanda – Lake Mburo

Drive through the Uganda Highlands to Kabale, then continue on to Lake Mburo National Park. You will have the opportunity

to go on a walk with a local guide (own expense) or a game drive (included). Overnight accommodation KIMBLA MANTANA TENTED CAMP (B, L, D)

Day 6: Lake Mburo – Entebbe

This morning you will depart back to Entebbe, stopping en route at the Royal Drum makers, and the chance to shop for curios. You will arrive in Entebbe in the afternoon where your tour comes to an end. (B)

UGANDA ADVENTURE

13 Days / 12 Nights

Whilst the highlight of this exciting safari is trekking to find the gorillas & chimps, you will get to see other game like tree climbing lions, hippos and an endless variety of plains game as well as visiting local villages. This is for those wanting an adventurous participation overland safari.

Day 1: Entebbe – Lake Mburo Nat. Park

Departing from Entebbe this afternoon you enter the Lake Mburo National Park to camp on the Lake shore. CAMPING. (D)

Day 2: Bwindi Impenetrable Forest

Enjoy a game drive/walk before departing for Bwindi Impenetrable Forest. CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Days 3 & 4: Bwindi Gorilla Trek

On day 3 or 4 in small groups you will trek up into the forest with local guides to locate and spend time with the gorillas. CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Days 5 & 6: Q. E. National Park - Ishasha

Today you will depart for Queen Elizabeth National Park, where you will spend two nights at a remote camp. CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Q. E. Nat Park - Chimpanzees

Today you will travel to Kyambura Gorge. In the afternoon hike the Gorge with a guide in search of wild chimpanzees. CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Rwenzori Mountains

This morning continue north to the Rwenzori. Enjoy walks through rural villages and forests to the Rwenzori lookout point. CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Day 9: Murchison Falls Nat. Park

Today you will depart for KANIYO-PABIDI CAMP in Murchison Falls National Park. You may opt for a trek with the chimpanzees (own expense). (B, L, D)

Day 10: Murchison Falls / Victoria Nile

Today you will explore the Murchison Falls before boarding a boat to take you downstream on a game cruise to your campsite. CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary

This afternoon you will exit the Park and visit the Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary. CAMPING. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Jinja

This morning you may opt to do Rhino tracking (own expense). You will spend your last night in Jinja at ADRIFT CAMP and enjoy a 'farewell' dinner (own expense). (B, L)

Day 13: Jinja

Tour ends this morning after breakfast. (B)
