Ruckomechi Luxury Camp

Day 1: Victoria Falls / Mana Pools National Park

Today you will board your charter flight from Victoria Falls to Mana Pools. On arrival at the airstrip you will be met by a representative and transferred to your camp. Situated on the western boundary of Mana Pools National Park, Ruckomechi Camp is a naturalists' paradise. The mystical Zambezi River forms the northern border of the area with a wide variety of habitats evident - open floodplains, mopane woodland and riverine forest with the mountains of the Rift Valley escarpment forming the backdrop in neighbouring Zambia. Ruckomechi Camp accommodates guests in ten spacious en-suite tented units, including a honeymoon suite, all of which overlook the Zambezi River. Each tent has both indoor and outdoor showers, and the camp boasts a favourite amongst guests: its outdoor 'bath-with-a-view' in a secluded, scenic spot. The central dining, bar, library and lounge areas face the escarpment and are connected to the rest of the camp by low-level walkways. There is a separate deck with infinity pool for swimming and sun bathing, and an inviting, cushion-strewn star gazing deck. 3 nights at RUCKOMECHI CAMP. (L, D)

Days 2 & 3: Mana Pools National Park

Days spent experiencing the wildlife on the various activities at the camp. Activities include wildlife viewing in open 4x4 vehicles, on motorised pontoon boats, on foot and in canoes. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Mana Pools National Park / Victoria Falls

You will be transferred by a representative from the camp back to the airstrip. Board your charter flight back to Victoria Falls where your tour ends. (B)

BEST OF ZAMBIA

11 Days / 10 Nights

Although still relatively untouched, Zambia offers some of the best game viewing in Southern Africa. This safari visits one of the most exciting areas, South Luangwa National Park, as well as one of the most beautiful - Lower Zambezi National Park, right on the Zambezi River. With good accommodation, great food and friendly service this is a must for those looking for something different.

Day 1: Lusaka – South Luangwa

You will be flown from Lusaka to South Luangwa, and transferred to your lodge. Enjoy 2 nights at KAFUNTA RIVER LODGE. This lodge has the only natural hot spring tub in the area and offers magnificent views. (L, D)

Days 2: South Luangwa

Day spent exploring the wildlife in the Mfuwe area. Game activities include game viewing in open vehicles and unique night drives. (B, L, D)

Days 3, 4 & 5: South Luangwa

Embark on a two hour drive through the remote wilderness to ISLAND BUSH CAMP for 3 nights. This camp offers rustic accommodation

in grass/reed huts, each with a private verandah. The camp is your base for daily morning and afternoon walking safaris. (B, L, D)

Day 6: South Luangwa

Today you will journey back to KAFUNTA RIVER LODGE, with it's amazing views, for an overnight stay. (B, L, D)

Day 7: South Luangwa – Lower Zambezi

You will transfer to Mfuwe airstrip for your flight via Lusaka to Lower Zambezi. On arrival you will be transferred to your lodge. Enjoy 4 nights at KASAKA RIVER LODGE, a luxury tented camp nestled on the banks of the Zambezi River. (B, L, D)

Days 8-10: Lower Zambezi

Days are spent discovering the Zambezi River by boat or canoe. Daily activities also include game drives and walking safaris. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Lower Zambezi – Lusaka

Today you will be transferred to the airstrip for your return flight to Lusaka.
