

Mashatu Game Reserve is located in South East Botswana and is easily accessible from South Africa. It is a diverse wilderness of savannah, riverine forests, marshland, open plains and sandstone outcrops. The reserve is also the home of no less than seven of Africa's giants: the African elephant, the lion, giraffe, the baobab tree, the eland, the ostrich, and the kori bustard. Mashatu Game Reserve proudly provides a refuge for some 366 species of birds and the largest, single population of elephant on privately owned land in Africa



Mashatu Main Camp

Mashatu Main Camp (5 star)

Mashatu Main Camp is the larger and more luxurious of Mashatu's camps, with 14 authentically decorated luxury suites. The suites lie along the camp's perimeter, and are designed to allow absolute privacy. Each is furnished with two three-quarter beds, a day bed and expansive ensuite bathroom. Your private lounge area overlooks the unfenced surrounding bush, and as Mashatu Main Camp is elevated around a waterhole, game viewing is excellent from within the camp. Facilities include a swimming pool, air-conditioned lounge and dining room, and a lala-palm enclosed African boma.

Mashatu Tented Camp (3 star)

Mashatu Tented Camp is nestled in the remote northern area of the reserve, and is a truly idyllic getaway. Although rustic in character, every facility is provided - 8 completely private comfortable tents are tucked under the branches of enormous trees, accessible via meandering pathways. All are insect-proofed, with comfortable beds and private en-suite bathroom. Meals are served on an open-sided thatch deck, or in the boma overlooking a floodlit and popular waterhole. A plunge pool provides a refreshing break from the unrelenting sunshine typical of the summer months.

OKAVANGO HOUSEBOAT

3 Days / 2 Nights

For a Botswana safari experience with a difference, enjoy a relaxing three day cruise on a luxury houseboat on the Panhandle area of the Okavango Delta. This area is recognized as being amongst the quietest and most peaceful in the Delta due to its remoteness. Activities from the boat include fishing, birdwatching, boat safaris and visits to the Tsodilo Hills to view the World Heritage Site San Rock Paintings.

Day 1: Maun / Okavango Delta

On arrival at Maun Airport you will be met and transferred by road to the "panhandle" area of the Okavango Delta for two nights on board the KABBO HOUSEBOAT. The Houseboat is like a floating Lodge and consists of 2 decks. The lower deck has 8 en-suite cabins with sliding glass doors opening on to the pristine wilderness that is the Okavango Delta. This design offers guests unrivalled views of the crystal clear waterways. The Upper Deck is approximately three meters above the waterline, where the dining area, bar and open deck are situated. Here the views that are simply breathtaking when having sundowners and the privacy and convenience of en-suite cabins allow ample space for guests to have some "alone" time. (D)

Day 2: Okavango Delta

A full day is spent experiencing the wildlife and enjoying the activities onboard the houseboat - includes one water-based activity with additional optional activities available. Activities include fishing, bird watching, boating and visit to Tsodilo Hills for San rock paintings. Overnight on board the houseboat. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Okavango Delta/Maun

After breakfast, you will disembark from the houseboat and will then be transferred by road back to Maun Airport. (B)
