

This amazing adventure holiday takes in some of Africa's most diverse and exciting regions. From the lofty majestic Table Mountain in Cape Town, South Africa, to the giant dry red dunes of Sossusvlei, Namibia, and the game-rich labyrinth of lagoons, and channels of the Okavango Delta, Botswana, this is an experience rich safari in the heart of Southern Africa.

Day 1: Cape Town

This morning you will be taken on a full day Peninsula tour. A morning or afternoon cable car ascent up Table Mountain is included (weather dependent). Overnight BREAKWATER LODGE or similar. (B)

Day 2: Calvinia (Hantam Region)

Today you will pass through the Namaqualand region with spectacular views from the Van Ryns Pass before arriving at Calvinia. Overnight HANTAM HUIS or similar. (B)

Day 3: Au-grabies Falls National Park

Today you will head North to the Au-grabies Falls National Park. Spend the afternoon enjoying the Falls of Orange River from its many viewpoints. Overnight VERGELEGEN GUEST HOUSE or similar. (B)

Days 4 & 5: Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park

Today you will head north into the Kalahari and the magnificent Kgalagadi Transfrontier Park where you will enjoy a game drive. Optional activities are available (at own expense). Overnight XAUS LODGE or similar. (B)

Days 6 & 7: Fish River Canyon

Today you enter Namibia. The next morning

is free before visiting Fish River Canyon.

Overnight VOGELSTRAUSSKLUFT COUNTRY LODGE. (B)

Days 8 & 9: Sesriem

Travel north to your accommodation located on the edge of the Namib Desert. The following morning is an early departure for Sossusvlei, stopping to take in the magnificent sunrise over the sand dunes. Enjoy walks to Sossusvlei and Deadvlei and through the Sesriem Canyon. Overnight DESERT CAMP or similar. (B)

Days 10 & 11: Swakopmund

Today you will reach the coast at Walvis Bay then head to Swakopmund, a German colonial town. Overnight SWAKOPMUND BOUTIQUE HOTEL or similar (B)

Day 12: Damaraland

Today drive through Damaraland with its vast & rugged terrain. Your lodge is located on top of a mountain. Overnight UGAB TERRACE LODGE or similar. (B)

Day 13: Himba Visit / Etosha National Park

In the morning you can visit the local Himba

tribe, amongst the most striking looking people in Africa, before proceeding to Etosha National Park for a game drive. Overnight OKAKEUJO RESTCAMP or similar. (B)

Day 14: Etosha National Park

The day is spent on game drives through the Park. Overnight HALALI RESTCAMP or similar. (B)

Days 15 & 16: Okavango River

Today you will enter the Caprivi Strip where and spend the night overlooking the Okavango River. Enjoy sunset on the deck or a swim in the famous "river pool". The following day is free. Overnight NGEPI CAMP TREEHOUSES or similar. (B)

Days 17 & 18: Chobe River

Crossing into Botswana you will overnight on the banks of the Chobe River. Relax on a sunset game-viewing cruise on the River. Optional game drive (own expense). Overnight CHOBE SAFARI LODGE or similar. (B)

Days 19 & 20: Livingstone/ Victoria Falls

Today you will travel across the Zambian border to Livingstone to view the magnificent Victoria Falls. Days are spent at leisure to browse the local markets or experience the many optional activities on offer. Overnight PROTEA HOTEL LIVINGSTONE or similar. (B)

Day 21: Livingstone

Tour ends after breakfast. (B)
