

THE ULTIMATE NAMIBIA WING SAFARI

9 Days / 8 Nights

This safari takes you by light aircraft to the most interesting areas, saving travelling time and allowing you to make the most of your journey. This is a land with the highest sand dunes in the world, at Sossusvlei, and a timeless landscape of shimmering plains and rugged mountains, which is Damaraland, as well as abundant game at Etosha National Park.

Day 1: Windhoek

Arrive Windhoek. Transfer to your hotel. Overnight VERTIGO BOUTIQUE HOTEL. (B)

Days 2 & 3: Windhoek - Sossusvlei

Transfer to Eros airport and depart Windhoek by light aircraft. Activities at camp are conducted in 4WD vehicles and include a safari to the end of the Tsauchab River and the heart of Sossusvlei. Two nights at LITTLE KULALA LODGE. (B, L, D)

Days 4 & 5: Sossusvlei - Damaraland

Today you will board your light aircraft and fly over the dunes of Namib Desert and the Skeleton Coast then inland to Northern Damaraland. Two nights at DAMARALAND CAMP or DESERT RHINO CAMP. (B, L, D)

Days 6 & 7: Damaraland - Etosha

Today you will fly by light aircraft to Ongava. Enjoy game drives in Etosha National Park, as well as night drives and walks. The Park is known for its black and white rhino, large numbers of plains game and over three hundred species of birds. Two nights ONGAVA TENTED CAMP or ONGAVA LODGE. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Etosha National Park - Windhoek

Fly from Etosha to Windhoek and transfer to your hotel. Overnight VERTIGO BOUTIQUE HOTEL. (B)

Day 9: Windhoek

Today you will be transferred to the airport for your onward flight. (B)
