

Egypt is regarded as the cradle of history and culture and is famous for the Pyramids, the Sphinx, its great temples and towering obelisks. It is one of the oldest civilisations on Earth which gives modern day Egypt its vitality. This itinerary has been designed around the luxury "Nile Adventurer", a Nile cruise vessel which offers excellent accommodation, with first class service.



Pyramid

Day 1: Cairo

On arrival at Cairo International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your overnight accommodation at THE GRAND HYATT CAIRO. (B)

Day 2: Cairo

Full day tour to Memphis to see the statue of Rameses II, and Sakkara to view the Step Pyramid of Zoser I, finishing the day at the great pyramids at Giza and the Sphinx. Overnight at THE GRAND HYATT CAIRO. (B)

Day 3: Cairo - Luxor

Fly to Luxor for a day at leisure. Overnight at the OLD WINTER PALACE. (B)

Day 4: Nile Cruising

Board the Nile Adventurer for your four night cruise. It begins with a tour of the East Bank visiting The Temple of Karnak and The Temple of Luxor. After lunch you will tour the West Bank of Luxor and explore the Valley of the Kings. You will also see the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and the Colossi of Memnon. NILE ADVENTURER. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Nile Cruising

Today is a more relaxing day to take in the wonders of the Nile as you cruise to Esna. (B, L, D)

Day 6: Nile Cruising

After breakfast you will tour the Greco Roman Temple of Khnum at Esna. Lunch on board while you sail to Edfu. This afternoon explore the largest and most completely preserved Pharonic temple in Egypt - the Temple of Horus at Edfu. Return to the boat for an Egyptian cooking lesson and an "Egyptian Night" dinner on board which includes the Galabeyya party. NILE ADVENTURER. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Nile Cruising

This morning, you will visit the Temple of Kom Ombo. Lunch on board while you sail to Aswan. Take a short motorboat ride to visit

the romantic and majestic Philae Temple on the Island of Agilka. In the afternoon take a ride on a felucca - a typical Egyptian sail boat - around Elephantine Island, Lord Kitchener's Botanical Gardens, and Agha Khan Mausoleum. NILE ADVENTURER. (B, L, D)

Day 8: Aswan - Cairo

Take an optional tour to Abu Simbel (at an additional cost) where you can visit the colossal temples of Ramses II and his Queen, Nefetari. You will be transferred to Aswan airport for your flight to Cairo where you will be met and transferred to your hotel the GRAND HYATT CAIRO. (B)

Day 9: Cairo

Morning visit to the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, before visiting the oldest area of Cairo where you can explore the remains of the Fortress of Babylon. Finish your tour today at the oldest Synagogue in Egypt, Ben Ezra. Overnight at THE GRAND HYATT CAIRO. (B)

Day 10: Cairo

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Cairo airport for your onward flight. (B)
